McCune Community



An assisted and independent living facility owned and operated by our MD31C (Multiple District) under the entity of Western NC Lions located in Black Mountain, NC in Buncombe County.

The facility was named in honor of Marjorie McCune, the first blind social worker in Buncombe County, who approached the Western NC Lions with a vision for a long-term happy home for blind and visually impaired individuals.

VIP Fishing Tournament



A three-day event filled with recreation, fellowship, and independent living workshops for blind and visually impaired persons located on the coast of NC on the Outer Banks. This event is the largest of this kind in the world and attracts VIPS from all over NC and all over the country.

A Guide Dog school located in Rochester Hills, Michigan that was founded by members of the Uptown Lions Club of Detroit. Leader Dogs is 100% philanthropically funded by individual donors, Lions clubs, corporate partners and foundations.
